

Signed in 1935, the Roerich Pact paved the way for landmark international legal instruments devoted to the protection of cultural property, both in peacetime and during war – including the 1954 Hague Convention for the Protection of Cultural Property in the Event of Armed Conflict and its two (1954 and 1999) Protocols. The UNESCO World Heritage Convention, adopted in 1972, builds on the spirit of the Pact





Within the framework of this Project in 2013 the distinctive flag of the Roerich Pact, known as the Banner of Peace, was consecrated at the main Cathedral of Buenos Aires in Argentina.



The first consecration of the Banner of Peace took place at the Basilica of the Holy Blood in Bruges (Belgium) in 1931 during the first International Conference for the Roerich Pact.






